EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This report presents the findings of the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) performed by Pam Denison of Sayers & Associates, Inc. on land and improvements located at 4822 E. Cesar Chavez in Austin, Travis County, Texas. Based on the results of this investigation, it is believed that there may be surface or subsurface contamination. Also a number of possible offsite sources of surface and subsurface contamination were identified in the vicinity of the subject property; however, these are unlikely to impact the subject. These sources are described in the following report.

Chain-of-title, city directories, and historical aerial photographs indicate that the property was commercial as early as 1950.

The site consists of approximately 71,438 square feet of land which has a large commercial building and two small sheds per Travis Central Appraisal District (TCAD).

Regulatory agency databases were researched to determine what hazardous or potentially hazardous sites might affect the subject property and they are as follows:

There were no National Priority sites within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 08/15/96.

There were no State Superfund sites within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 03/31/96.

There were no CERCLIS sites within 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 08/15/96.

The subject property was not on the RCRA Generators report as of 05/24/96, but the east adjacent property, Central Machine Works at 4824 E. Cesar Chavez, was on the list.

There were no TSD facilities within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 05/24/96.

There were two Violators within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 05/24/96.

The subject property was not on the ERNS as of 07/11/96.

There was one TRI facility within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 1993.

There were two Municipal Solid Waste Facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 08/29/96.

There were 17 PST facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 07/03/96.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY (cont.)

There are no registered PSTs on the subject property. There are three closed unregistered PSTs on the subject property. None of the PST facilities present on other properties represent an immediate threat to the subject property. However, the EPA has estimated that as many as 24% of all petroleum storage tanks are leaking.

There were five LPST facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 09/11/96. These LPSTs do not represent an immediate threat to the subject property because of their distance and direction from the subject property. There were no LPSTs on the subject or adjacent properties.

There were no reported spills within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 07/01/96.

There were six HMS facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 1991.

There were no facilities on the FINDS as of 11/29/95, other than those reported elsewhere in this report.

The possible sources of off-site contamination identified in this report do not presently affect the subject property although they could pose future potential risks. While no testing for contamination was performed, it is my opinion that further environmental assessment needs to be performed on the subject property as follows:

- 1. Soil sampling for hydrocarbons should be performed at the site of the three underground storage tanks (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda).
- 2. The hydraulic lift (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda) should be tested for:
 - a. The presence of PCBs (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
 - b. Leaking
- 3. Soil sampling for lead should be performed at the site of the paint shed (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda).
- 4. The trash piles (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda) should be checked for hazards and disposed of.

INTRODUCTION

This report presents the results of the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) performed by Pam Denison of Sayers & Associates, Inc. on approximately 71,438 square feet of land with improvements located at 4822 E. Cesar Chavez in Austin, Travis County, Texas. This Phase I Environmental Site Assessment was authorized on October 10, 1996, and was performed in accordance with generally accepted standards.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The purpose of this ESA was to provide information to John H. Corbin, President of East Austin Concert Hall, Inc., to evaluate potential environmental problems associated with the subject property. In conducting the ESA, the property was inspected for visible signs of possible contamination, public records were researched, and interviews were conducted with representatives of regulatory agencies. These steps were performed to determine the need, if any, for additional environmental sampling, research, or soil/groundwater investigation. The following items were included in the assessment:

Historical site usage of subject and adjacent properties
Environmental setting
On-site survey of subject property including current use of adjacent properties
Research and interviews with public and regulatory agencies, including reports

Certain environmental hazards are impossible to visually identify, and can only be verified by testing and analysis. No samples were collected, and no wetlands investigation or fault studies were made as a part of this investigation.

REPORT ORGANIZATION

This report is organized into sections which discuss and present document reviews, field investigation findings, and regulatory research findings. Conclusions and recommendations, references, and professional qualifications are included to complete the report. Photographs, maps, and other supporting documentation are included in the Addenda.

LIMITATIONS

This report has been prepared to aid John H. Corbin, President of East Austin Concert Hall, Inc., in identifying and addressing environmental site conditions on the subject property. This report is prepared for John H. Corbin, President of East Austin Concert Hall, Inc.'s sole benefit and may not be relied upon by any other person or entity without the written authorization of Sayers & Associates, Inc.

INTRODUCTION (Cont.)

During this Phase I Environmental Site Assessment, Pam Denison of Sayers & Associates, Inc. relied on interviews of individuals and has assumed, where reasonable to do so, that the information provided is true and accurate. If information to the contrary is discovered, our conclusions and recommendations may not be valid. No direct inferences can be made as to the subsurface conditions at the site based on the Phase I scope of work, which does not include a detailed investigation of the subsurface.

The conclusions and recommendations describe only the conditions present at the time of our assessment, in areas that were observed. The scope of this report is limited to matters expressly covered. The site assessment was performed in general accordance with the standards of care and diligence normally practiced by recognized consulting firms in performing services of a similar nature.

This report is not intended to convey the opinion that the site contains no other hazardous or toxic material beyond that observed or found by Sayers & Associates, Inc. Environmental analysis involves the inherent risk that all contamination on site may not have been fully revealed by the exploratory observations because conditions may vary throughout the site.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The subject property is located at 4822 E. Cesar Chavez, Austin, Travis County, Texas. The legal description of the site is as follows:

Being all the lots, tracts or parcels situated in Lot 1, in the Capitol Machine Works Addition, being in the City of Austin, Travis County, Texas.

The subject property is zoned "LI" - limited industrial. As of the date of this report the property was used as an import business with a shipping area.

A plat map is included in the Addenda.

Peter Von Wupperfeld, the owner's agent, interviewed John Simecek and Dan Bartosh, owners, (questionnaire is included in the Addenda) regarding the following, to the best of their knowledge:

Industrial Use: The subject property and adjoining properties have been known to be used for industrial purposes.

Other Uses: The subject property has been known to be used as a gasoline station and motor repair facility but not as a commercial printing facility, dry cleaners, photo developing laboratory, junkyard or landfill, or as a waste treatment, storage, disposal, processing, or recycling facility.

Storage: There have been no known damaged or discarded automotive or industrial batteries, or pesticides, paints or other chemicals in individual containers of greater than five gallons (19 L) in volume or 50 gallon (190 L) in the aggregate, stored on or used at subject property.

Chemicals: There have been no known industrial drums (typically 55 gallons (208 L)) or sacks of chemicals located on the subject property.

Fill Dirt: Fill dirt has not been known to be brought onto the subject property that originated from a contaminated site or that is of an unknown origin.

Pits, Ponds, Lagoons: There have been no known pits, ponds, or lagoons located on the subject property in connection with waste treatment or waste disposal.

Stained Soil: There has been no known stained soil on the subject property.

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION (Cont.)

Storage Tanks: There are three unregistered underground storage tanks located on the subject property that were used for gasoline from 1948 - 1953. They were closed down by Sinclair Oil in approximately 1953. The gasoline was pumped out, the tanks were washed and then filled with sand.

Vent or Fill Pipes: There have been no known vent pipes, fill pipes, or access ways indicating a fill pipe protruding from the ground on the subject property.

Stains: There have been no known flooring, drains, or walls located within the facility that were stained by substances other than water or that emitted foul odors.

Water System: The subject property has not been known to be served by a private well or non-public water system.

Environmental Liens: There have been no known environmental liens or governmental notifications relating to past or recurrent violations of environmental laws with respect to the subject property or any facility located on the subject property.

Hazardous Substances or Petroleum Products: The owner has never been informed of the past or current existence of hazardous substances or petroleum products or environmental violations with respect to the subject property or any facility located on the property. The owner has no knowledge of any environmental site assessment of the subject property or facility that indicated the presence of hazardous substances or petroleum products on, or contamination of, the property or recommended further assessment of the property.

Lawsuits or Administrative Proceedings: The owner knows of no past, threatened, or pending lawsuits or administrative proceedings concerning a release or threatened release of any hazardous substance or petroleum products involving the subject property by any owner or occupant of the subject property.

Waste Water: The subject property has no known discharges of waste water on or adjacent to the subject property other than storm water into a sanitary sewer system.

Disposal: There have been no known hazardous substances or petroleum products, unidentified waste materials, tires, automotive or industrial batteries or any other waste materials dumped above grade, buried and/or burned on the subject property.

PCBs: There are no known transformers, capacitors, or any hydraulic equipment for which there are any records indicating the presence of PCBs.

SITE BACKGROUND AND OPERATIONS HISTORY

The following information was reviewed to determine past and current uses of the subject and adjacent properties.

DEED RECORDS

A review of the deeds for the subject property was performed by Ameristar Information Network, Inc. to track the previous owners of the property, and possibly to indicate previous land usage. The deed search tracked the ownership of the property from 03/29/44 through 10/11/96.

The deed records disclosed no previous or present owners which indicate a use of the property which could be considered adverse.

The Deed Search is included in the Addenda.

CITY DIRECTORIES

City directories from 1953 through 1996 were reviewed by Ameristar Information Network, Inc. to estimate previous uses of the subject and adjacent properties.

This research indicated that there has been a lot of automotive businesses in the area and on the subject property which could cause environmental problems.

Detailed City Directory Research is included in the Addenda.

SANBORNS INSURANCE MAPS

Sanborns Insurance Maps of Austin for 1957 show the property is occupied by Capitol Truck & Trailer Co. The street address 4722 E. 1st Street. Many of the surrounding business are construction companies and machine shops.

HISTORICAL AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS

Aerial photographs of the subject property and the surrounding areas were reviewed.

The subject and surrounding properties appear to be commercial in both the 1966 and 1990 photographs, with the trees larger in the 1990 photograph. There are no unusual features identified from our review of the aerial photographs.

Copies of the aerial photographs are included in the Addenda.

ENVIRONMENTAL SETTINGS

The following paragraphs discuss the general environmental setting of the subject property.

TOPOGRAPHY AND SURFACE DRAINAGE

The subject property lies at an elevation of approximately 450 feet above mean sea level. The general terrain of the area is flat. Surface drainage and runoff are directed southeast to the Colorado River.

A map is included in the Addenda.

SOILS

According to the Travis County Soil Survey, the subject property rests on soils that have been classified as Bergstrom soils and Urban land, with slope ranges from zero to two percent (90% with a slope of .5 percent or less).

GROUNDWATER

Major groundwater aquifers in the Austin area include the Edwards Aquifer. The majority of water produced for domestic use is taken from the lower portions of the Edwards Aquifer. A review of information provided by the Texas Water Development Board indicates drinking water production in the vicinity of the subject property occurs at depths of over 600 feet below ground surface (bgs). Regional groundwater generally follows the topography; therefore, it is expected to flow towards the Colorado River and then to the southeast towards the Gulf of Mexico. However, local conditions may alter groundwater flow directions.

OIL AND GAS WELLS

Oil and gas well location maps provided by GeoMaps and USGS (topographic map) were reviewed to determine if oil and gas wells were located on the subject or in the general vicinity. According to these maps, no oil or gas wells are located on or within several miles of the subject property.

ON-SITE SURVEY

The on-site property inspection was performed by Pam Denison of Sayers & Associates, Inc. at 4822 E. Cesar Chavez on October 29, 1996. Peter Von Wupperfeld, the owners' agent, was also present. During the site inspection, all accessible areas of the property were walked and examined for any evidence of hazardous materials. Surface conditions were observed and adjacent properties were identified.

CURRENT USE

The main building is currently used by Brinks Design as an import showroom and for shipping merchandise. Most of their items are imported from Mexico.

LAND

The site has frontage along E. Cesar Chavez and E. Fifth Street and contains approximately 71,438 square feet of land area (per TCAD).

IMPROVEMENTS

The main building, built in approximately 1940, has approximately 11,340 square feet (per TCAD). There are three underground storage tanks under the car port at the front of the building that were used for gasoline from 1948 - 1953. The owners informed us that the tanks were closed down by Sinclair Oil in approximately 1953. The gasoline was pumped out, the tanks were washed and then filled with sand. In the northwest corner of the building is a hydraulic lift.

There are two sheds on the back of the property. The small one on the far north side of the property is vacant. The larger one to the west appears to have been used as a paint shed. There is black paint visible on the walls and there are many cans of aerosol paint sitting in the shed.

OTHER OBSERVATIONS

The property has a fairly flat topography and no indications were observed that might indicate a hazardous waste spill.

There are two large piles of trash; one is north of the main building and the other is north of the paint shed. In these trash piles are old machine parts, tires and other debris.

See the Land Sketch in the Addenda for approximate location of items mentioned.

ON-SITE SURVEY (Cont.)

TRANSFORMERS

The Toxic Substance Control Act regulates any transformer containing Polychlorinated Biphenyl (PCB) mineral oil with a concentration greater than 50 ppm. Such transformers are considered PCB-contaminated and require appropriate remediation should they be found to be stained or leaking.

One pole mounted transformer was observed on the subject property. It appeared to be in good condition and no staining or leaking was observed.

According to Susan Gurly of the City of Austin, Electric Utility Field Service, since no identifying numbers were observed, it cannot be verified whether this transformer has been tested for PCBs, and is assumed to be PCB-contaminated.

See the Land Sketch in the Addenda for approximate location of the transformers.

ADJACENT PROPERTIES

The following section identifies the structures and apparent usage of the properties adjacent to the subject.

North:

Fifth Street

This property should cause no environmental concern to the subject.

South:

Construction Co. and an auto shop

These properties should cause no environmental concern to the subject.

East:

Machine shop

This property should cause no environmental concern to the subject.

West:

Library

This property should cause no environmental concern to the subject.

No superficial conditions, such as damaged vegetation, that might indicate contamination originating from adjacent properties were observed on the subject property.

A land sketch and photographs are included in the Addenda.

RESEARCH AND INTERVIEWS WITH PUBLIC AND REGULATORY AGENCIES

REVIEW OF FEDERAL AND STATE ENVIRONMENTAL DATABASES

On October 25, 1996, Data Site, Inc. researched federal and state environmental databases for data regarding the subject property and surrounding properties using various search distances. The results of this research were reviewed by Pam Denison of Sayers & Associates, Inc. and are described in the following paragraphs.

National Priorities List (NPL)/Superfund Sites - One mile radius

This is a list compiled by EPA pursuant to Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA) of properties with the highest priority for cleanup pursuant to EPA's Hazard Ranking System.

There were no National Priority sites within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 08/15/96.

State Superfund Sites - One mile radius

Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) maintains a superfund registry for Texas.

There were no State Superfund sites within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 03/31/96.

<u>Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Information System (CERCLIS)</u> - 0.5 mile radius

Each region of the EPA produces a Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Information System (CERCLIS) list. This is a list of potential hazardous waste sites identified by the EPA.

There were no CERCLIS sites within 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 08/15/96.

Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA):

The EPA Resource Conservation and Recovery Information System (RCRIS) serves to track the status of registrations, permits, reports, inspections, enforcement activities, and financial data of those regulated under the RCRA.

A list is included in the Addenda.

RESEARCH AND INTERVIEWS WITH PUBLIC & REGULATORY AGENCIES (Cont.)

Generators List - Subject and adjacent properties only

This is a list kept by EPA of those persons or entities that generate hazardous wastes, as defined and regulated by RCRA.

The subject property was not on the RCRA Generators report as of 05/24/96, but the east adjacent property, Central Machine Works at 4824 E. Cesar Chavez, was on the list. Paul Mask, Manager, indicated that H&H Waste Oil picks up their used motor oil when the barrel is full which is about once a month.

Treatment, Storage, and Disposal (TSD) Facilities - One mile radius

This is a list of those facilities on which treatment, storage, and/or disposal of hazardous wastes takes place, as defined and regulated by RCRA.

There were no TSD facilities within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 05/24/96.

Violators - One mile radius

This report lists sites which have undergone a Compliance Evaluation inspection. Several items are subject to inspection during these evaluations, including waste manifest records, financial responsibility, land ban regulations, and others.

There were two Violators within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 05/24/96.

Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS) - Subject property only

The ERNS serves to store information on releases of oil and hazardous substances. Releases are recorded in ERNS when they are initially reported to the federal government by any party. ERNS combines data from the National Response Center and the EPA.

The subject property was not on the ERNS as of 07/11/96.

Toxic Release Inventory (TRI) - One mile radius

This list contains emissions data for those companies having to report their emissions according to Superfund (CERCLA) Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) Title III Section 302 requirements.

RESEARCH AND INTERVIEWS WITH PUBLIC & REGULATORY AGENCIES (Cont.)

There was one TRI facility within a one mile radius of the subject property as of 1993.

A list is included in the Addenda.

Municipal Solid Waste Facilities - 0.5 mile radius

The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) Municipal Solid Waste Registration and Permit database serves to track permits and registrations for landfills, transfer stations, sludge application sites, illegal dump sites, recycling facilities, medical waste generators and transporters.

There were two Municipal Solid Waste Facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 08/29/96. Austin Liquid Disposal Company (M1) is a proposed site that has received a permit as a grease and grit trap waste processing facility. Michael L. Briggle (M2) is a proposed site that has submitted application to be a grease and grit trap waste processing facility.

Petroleum Storage Tanks (PST) - 0.5 mile radius

The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) maintains a list of registered petroleum storage tank (PST) locations.

There were 17 PST facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 07/03/96. There are no registered PSTs on the subject property. There are three closed unregistered PSTs on the subject property which were discussed previously in the report. None of the PST facilities present on other properties represent an immediate threat to the subject property. However, the EPA has estimated that as many as 24% of all petroleum storage tanks are leaking.

TNRCC Petroleum Storage Tanks Listing Report is included in the Addenda.

Data Site map in the Addenda plots PSTs within a .5 mile radius of the subject property.

Leaking Petroleum Storage Tanks (LPST) - 0.5 mile radius

The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) maintains a list of leaking petroleum storage tank (LPST) locations.

There were five LPST facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 09/11/96. These LPSTs do not represent an immediate threat to the subject property because

of their distance and direction from the subject property. There were no LPSTs on the subject or adjacent properties.

TNRCC Leaking Tank Sites Listing Report is included in the Addenda.

Data Site map in the Addenda plots LPSTs within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property.

Spill Responses - 0.5 mile radius

The Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) Spill Response database serves to track all reported spills to the TNRCC Texas Emergency Response Center of a harmful quantity of oil and hazardous substances or other substances or a release or threatened release.

There were no reported spills within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 07/01/96.

Hazardous Materials Storage (HMS) Facilities - 0.5 mile radius

The Texas Department of Health Hazardous Materials Storage (HMS) registration database serves to track annual compliance reporting required under SARA Title III and the Texas Hazard Communication Act.

There were six HMS facilities within a 0.5 mile radius of the subject property as of 1991.

A list is included in the Addenda.

EPA Facility Index System Listing Report - radius varies

The EPA Facility Index System (FINDS) acts as an inventory of facilities regulated by the EPA.

There were no facilities on the FINDS as of 11/29/95, other than those reported elsewhere in this report.

CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A Phase I Environmental Site Assessment was conducted on the subject property. Based on the information gathered during the site assessment and research process, I believe that there may be surface or subsurface contamination. During the site assessment, a number of possible off-site sources of surface and subsurface contamination were found; however, they are unlikely to impact the subject. While no testing for contamination was performed and after carefully evaluating the results of the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment performed on the property, it is hereby recommended that further assessment needs to be performed on the subject property as follows:

- 1. Soil sampling for hydrocarbons should be performed at the site of the three underground storage tanks (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda).
- 2. The hydraulic lift (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda) should be tested for:
 - a. The presence of PCBs (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
 - b. Leaking
- 3. Soil sampling for lead should be performed at the site of the paint shed (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda).
- 4. The trash piles (see Land and Building Sketch in the Addenda) should be checked for hazards and disposed of.








1957 SANBORNS INSURANCE MAP OF AUSTIN




PLAT MAP

Filled TANKS - 1953

Subchapter A General Provisions §§334.1-334.5

These sections are promulgated under the Texas Water Code, §\$26.341-26.359, as enacted in Senate Bill 779, 70th Legislature, 1987, which authorizes the Texas Water Commission to establish a program to regulate underground storage tanks and assess and collect fees for deposit to an underground storage tank fund, and under §\$5.103 and 5.105 which authorize the Texas Water Commission to adopt any rules necessary to carry out its powers and duties.

§334.1. Definitions. The following words and terms, when used in this chapter, shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

Compatible--The ability of two or more substances to maintain their respective physical and chemical properties upon contact with one another for extended periods of time and under varied environmental conditions (i.e., at different temperatures).

Facility--All contiguous land and associated improvements on which one or more underground storage tanks are located.

Person--An individual, trust, firm, joint-stock company, corporation, government corporation, partnership, association, state, municipality, commission, political subdivision of a state, an interstate body, a consortium, joint venture, commercial entity, or the United States government.

Regulated substance--An element, compound, mixture, solution, or substance that, when released into the environment, may present substantial danger to the public health, welfare, or the environment.

Release--Any spilling including overfilling, leaking, emitting, discharging, escaping, leaching, or disposing from an underground storage tank into groundwater, surface water, or subsurface soils.

Underground storage tank--Any one or combination of underground tanks and any connecting underground pipes used to contain an accumulation of regulated substances, the volume of which, including the volume of the connecting underground pipes, is 10% or more beneath the surface of the ground.

- §334.2. Regulated Substances.
- (a) Regulated substances under this chapter include:
 - (1) a substance defined in the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980, §101(14) (42 United States Code §9601 et seq.), but does not include a substance regulated as a hazardous waste under the federal Solid Waste Disposal Act (42 United States Code §6921 et seq.);

- (2) petroleum, including crude oil or a fraction of it, that is liquid at standard conditions of temperature and pressure; and
- (3) any other substance designated by the commission.
- (b) Standard conditions of temperature and pressure under subsection (a)(2) of this section are 60°F and 14.7 pounds per square inch absolute.

§334.3. Exemptions.

- (a) The following are exempt from regulation under this chapter:
 - (1) farm or residential tanks with a capacity of 1,100 gallons or less used for storing motor fuel for noncommercial purposes;
 - (2) tanks used for storing heating oil for consumptive use on the premises where stored;
 - (3) septic tanks;
 - (4) surface impoundments, pits, ponds, or lagoons;
 - (5) stormwater or wastewater collection systems;
 - (6) flow-through process tanks;
 - (7) tanks, liquid traps, gathering lines, or other facilities used in connection with an activity associated with the exploration, development, or production of oil, gas, or geothermal resources, or any other activity regulated by the Railroad Commission of Texas pursuant to the Natural Resources Code, §91.101; and
 - (8) storage tanks located in an underground area including a basement, cellar, mineworking, drift, shaft, or tunnel if the storage tank is located on or above the surface of the floor.
- (b) A pipeline facility, including gathering lines, is exempt from regulation under this chapter if it is regulated under:
 - (1) the Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Act of 1968 (49 United States Code, §1671 et seq.); or
 - (2) the Hazardous Liquid Pipeline Safety Act of 1979 (49 United States Code, §2001 et seq.).
- (c) An intrastate pipeline facility is exempt from regulation under this chapter if it is regulated under one of the following state laws:
 - (1) Natural Resources Code, Chapter 111;
 - (2) Natural Resources Code, Chapter 117; or
 - (3) Texas Civil Statutes, Articles 6053-1 and 6053-2.

§334.4 Registration and Construction Notification.

- (a) Tank registration requirements.
 - (1) General provision. All underground storage tanks in existence on September 1, 1987 must be registered by the owner of the underground storage tank with the commission not later than September 1,

1987 on forms supplied by or approved by the executive director, except for those tanks which:

(A) are exempt from regulation under §334.3 of this title (relating to Exemptions);

- (B) were registered with the commission prior to the effective date of this subchapter under the provisions of the federal Solid Waste Disposal Act, §9002 (42 United States Code, §6921 et seq.), provided that the owner has complied with the provisions of paragraph (3) of this subsection;
- (C) were permanently removed from the ground before May 8, 1986; or
- (D) remain in the ground, but were emptied and cleaned in accordance with accepted industry practices, and filled with inert material on or before January 1, 1974.
- (2) New or replacement tanks. Except as provided in paragraph (1) of this subsection, any person who owns a new or replacement underground storage tank that is placed into service on or after the effective date of this subchapter must register the tank with the executive director on an authorized form within 30 days from the date any regulated substance is placed into the tank.
- Changes or additional information. An owner of an underground storage tank subject to the provisions of this subchapter is required to provide written notice to the executive director of any changes or additional information concerning the status of any regulated tanks, including, but not limited to, information about the operational status, condition, substance stored, ownership, and information on other system components. notice must be provided on an authorized form which has been appropriately signed and which includes the facility identification number. Such notice must be filed with the executive director within 30 days from the date of occurrence or knowledge of the change in status of the underground storage tank.

Construction notification requirements.

(1) Installation or replacement.

(A) Except as provided under paragraph (4) of this subsection, any person who intends either to install or to have installed a new or replacement underground storage tank must notify the executive director in writing at least 30 days prior to initiating the installation or replacement activity. When requested by the executive director, such










